# Undergraduate Audition Information UNI Trombone Studio

Prospective students must be admitted into both the University of Northern Iowa and the School of Music before being considered as a member of the trombone studio. Please understand that admittance into the University of Northern Iowa does not guarantee admission into the School of Music. Admissions information can be found here.

### **Undergraduate Audition Process**

Prospective undergraduate trombonists may audition on either Friday, February 14, 2020 (Band Festival Participants Only), or Saturday, February 22, 2020 at the first of our School of Music Audition Day.

Auditions are scored by all brass faculty as a whole. Admission to the program is based on your ability to perform with good tone, intonation, pitch accuracy, rhythm, and musicality.

You will be expected to perform a short solo work or selected movements of a concerto or sonata totaling 5-7minutes. You should also be prepared to play any of the major scales, two octaves from memory and a small amount of sightreading.

I highly encourage all prospective students to visit UNI and have a free lesson with me before the audition. I would love to meet you and I would like for you to get a "first-hand" glance at how the trombone studio works and how I teach.

### **Tenor Trombone:** Required: Pg. 11 mm. 1-16 from Voxman *Selected Studies (quarter-note = 82)* in addition to one of the following:

Barat - Andante et Allegro
Guilmant - Morceau Symphonique (Concert Piece)
Saint-Saens - Cavatine
Sachse - Concertino
Telemann - Sonata in f minor myts 1 and 2
David - Concertino in Eb myts. 1 and 2

Tcherepnin – Andante

Barat – Introduction and Dance

Sachse – Concertino

Richard Lieb – Concertino Basso

Gordon Jacob – Cameos (mvts. 1,2, and 3)
